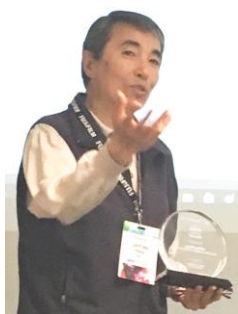

Jeffrey Wang Receives Circle of Excellence Award

Jeffrey Wang, Senior Color & Imaging Scientist at the Rochester Institute of Technology Printing Applications Laboratory, has been honored with an Idealliance Circle of Excellence Award for his work as a key driver for the development of Idealliance professional, system, and workflow certifications.

The award was presented to Wang at a Print Properties & Colorimetrics Council/Committee for Graphic Arts Technology Standards/U.S. Technical Advisory Group (PPC/CGATS/

USTAG) meeting hosted by Fujifilm in Hanover Park, Ill., earlier this month. Wang received a standing ovation from meeting attendees when the award was announced.

‘Indelible Footprint’

“Jeffrey Wang is an individual who truly represents servant leadership in every possible way,” said Tim Baechle, Idealliance Vice President, Global Print Technologies and Workflows, who presented the award. “His expertise, service, and dedication of time that he puts into serving the industry and others are humbling and the contributions he has made over the years have left an indelible footprint on the industry.”

The Idealliance Circle of Excellence Award was established in 2005 to recognize Members for their extraordinary contributions to the work of Idealliance. Nominations are made by the Idealliance staff with final selection by the Idealliance Board of Directors.

“Our Circle of Excellence Award recognizes the accomplishments of our members in service to the industry,” said David Steinhardt, Idealliance President and Chief Executive Officer. “Through their knowledge, dedication, and their generosity in giving their time and effort, these exemplary individuals are instrumental in continuing to move our industry forward.”

Wang joins three Idealliance members honored previously this year with Circle of Excellence Awards: Ben Cooper, Coalition for the 21st Century Postal Service, cited for his work representing the industry on Capitol Hill; Craig Dellinger, New Haven Print & Copy, honored for his focus on the needs of the owner-operator printing segment; and Tom Glassman of Wilen Direct, awarded for his service as founding Chair of the Postal Education Working Group and his work on Idealliance’s MailPro® Certification program.
