The Award is not based on business position or title and is meant to recognize an employee at any level of the industry. Nominations could include a press operator who serves as a volunteer firefighter, an account executive who leads a charity organization, or a CEO who shows significant dedication to community service.

HISTORY

The prestigious Zenger Community Service Medal is named for John Peter Zenger, an influential printer in American history. Zenger was a New York City-based printer whose arrest, imprisonment, trial, and acquittal in 1735 laid the foundation for freedom of the press in Colonial America. The Award is inscribed in Latin, "Non numinis, virtute parator." Translated, this means, "Not by money, but by virtue gained."
