WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A G7 MASTER:

G7 Master Qualification is granted to a physical facility. G7 Master status indicates that the facility has calibrated certain equipment and systems to G7 gray balance and neutral tone curves and is capable of delivering G7 proofs and print products. While many G7 Masters are printing companies, other graphic solutions providers such as creative and premedia providers may also be qualified as G7 Masters.

- Users of global standards to match proof-to-print across any process, ink, or substrate
- Committed to reducing costs, speeding product to market, and improving their client's brand image

HOW TO BECOME A G7 MASTER:

An Idealliance certified G7 Expert is required to qualify print facilities for the first time. A G7 Expert must be onsite to conduct and review calibration data, then submits an online application to Idealliance for 3rd party verification. Final G7 Master Qualification is granted by Idealliance.

ABOUT G7 EXPERTS/PROFESSIONALS:

An employee may become a Certified G7 Expert or G7 Professional, dependent upon the certification level they choose at registration and attain through examination. A G7 Expert is certified in the field of color management, process and quality control for proofing and printing utilizing the G7 methodology. A G7 Expert maintains Idealliance Membership and is listed in the Idealliance database of Certified Experts, Professionals and Qualified Masters. A certified G7 Professional is typically an in-house quality/technical professional. A G7 Professional may conduct and submit annual renewal applications.

G7 Master Qualification

Each application submitted for a facility:

- Requires Membership or Network Subscription
- Requires a New (\$350) or Renewal (\$100) Application Fee
- Requires minimum of one (1) Qualification Type with each Application, Grayscale/Targeted (\$100) or Colorspace (\$150)
- Qualification Types and Compliance Levels (Grayscale/Targeted/Colorspace) will be noted in the database listing
- G7 Expert consulting fees are additional, negotiated with, and paid to the G7 Expert
- Additional Qualification Types, Failed, or Resubmitted sheets are charged per Qualification Type, Grayscale/Targeted (\$100) or Colorspace (\$150)
- Good for one year
- Requires annual renewal by a Certified G7 Expert or G7 Professional
